The margins are 1.79 cm at the top and bottom and 1.65 cm on the left and right margins. The font of the document should be Garamond size 11 for the normal text, size 20 for the title and size 12 for the authors. The maximum heading depth is 3 levels. Headings are numbered using Arabic numerals. The first heading is centered, bold and capitalized. The second heading is left-aligned and bold. The third heading is left-aligned with normal font, for example:

Tables and figures should be cited in the text of the manuscript. In addition, they should have a numbered title at the top. If the tables and figures are not elaborated by the author, the source should be included below them and in the bibliographical references. Figures should be of very high quality in black and white or grayscale.
